MOTION TO STAY ARBITRATION

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 29, 1996, took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the City's Motion for Interim Cease and Desist Order to stay arbitration proceedings set for November 4, 1996, said motion being filed on October 23, 1996.
- It reviewed the Union's objections to the City's motion, said objections being filed on October 25, 1996.
- 3. It examined the City's unfair labor practice complaint filed July 22, 1996 alleging a wrongful demand to arbitrate and the Union's answer thereto filed on July 29, 1996.
- 4. It noted that the hearing on the ULP had been held and completed before the PELRB on September 26, 1996 and that a decision was pending thereon.
- 5. It found no matters of emergency or irreparable harm should this matter proceed to arbitration on November 4, 1996.

6. It DENIED the motion to stay the arbitration pending issuance of the Board's decision relating to the ULP.

So ordered.
