MOTION FOR REHEARING


The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 10, 1996, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the School District's Motion for Rehearing filed November 6, 1996, the Association's objection thereto filed November 21, 1996, the District's Amendment to its earlier Motion for Rehearing filed on November 26, 1996 and the Association's objection to the proposed amendment, both as to content and untimeliness, as filed on December 9, 1996.
2. It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) charge filed by the Association on May 31, 1996 and the District's answer filed on June 7, 1996.
3. It reviewed its decision (Decision 96-090) in this matter dated October 18, 1996.
4. It DENIED the District's Motion for Rehearing and it GRANTED the Association's motion objecting to the District's attempt to amend its

Motion for Rehearing because it was untimely,
and because it relied on facts alledged, i.e.,
a certification, which occurred after the
date of decision and which do not excuse the
contract breach with respect to Elaine French.
