The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire on February 27, 1997, took the following actions:

- 1. It convened to hear the positions of the parties in the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Dover Teachers Union (Union) against the Dover School Board (Board) on January 8, 1997, herein denominated as Case No. T-0392:5.
- Prior to opening arguments by the parties in Case No. T-0392:5, their representatives advised the PELRB as follows:

Based on the following paragraph, the Dover Teachers Union moves to withdraw Case T-0392:5 and the Dover

School Board moves to withdraw Case T-0392:6. The Dover Teachers Union and the Dover School Board agree to adhere to the ground rules executed by the parties on November 18, 1996, inclusive of the obligations imposed therein not to make or grant any press or broadcast media interviews about the course, content, progress or any other aspects of their on-going negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement. By way of clarification, this shall include a prohibition against unilateral press releases or any paid ads. It does not include a prohibition against such interviews for matters not related to the collective bargaining process now on-going between the parties.

3. The PELRB hereby incorporates the parties' agreement as and for its order. Case No. T-0392:5 and Case No. T-0392:6 are hereby DISMISSED consistent with the parties' agreement, as noted above.
