ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire on August 26, 1997, took the following actions:

- 1. It convened to hear the positions of the parties in the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Union on June 6, 1997 and answered by the Town on June 20, 1997.
- 2. At the commencement of the hearing, the Board heard representations from counsel for the respective parties that the Union would be willing to withdraw the pending complaint if the Town would agree to the following:

The Town of Stratham hereby agrees that it shall cease and desist from undertaking any further unilateral changes in the terms and conditions of employment, as defined by RSA 273-A:1 (IX), of the employees of the Town of Stratham Police Department and Public Works Department holding positions certified in the bargaining unit which is represented by Teamsters Local 633 of New

Hampshire.

3. It received the parties' written stipulation of even date that they had agreed to the foregoing language and, noting that agreement, the PELRB GRANTED this Union's Motion to withdraw.
