ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

The parties, represented by counsel or their duly appointed Union representatives, appeared before the undersigned hearing officer at the offices of the Board in Concord, New Hampshire on June 16, 1998 to present their respective arguments in the above-captioned case. After marking exhibits for the hearing, they advised the hearing officer that they had agreed that the Union would withdraw its unfair labor practice complaint and that the parties would proceed to meet in order to develop a protocol for the operation of trucks operated by members of the bargaining unit, with particular attention to be given to the rules and methods for operating those vehicles as the result of the issuance of the memo from Public Works Director Jack Petkus on January 5, 1998. The Union named Walter Sage, Ron White and Paul Westaway to its team. The City's team, inclusive of Jack Petkus, will be announced when the parties next meet on June 19, 1998.

The hearing officer adopts the foregoing agreement of the parties as and for the Order in this case, with the parties to next meet on June 19, 1998 in furtherance of the agreements herein and with the unfair labor practice complaint being dismissed hereby.
