MOTION TO CONTINUE

Based on written representations from counsel for Sullivan County dated June 11, 1998 and filed June 12, 1998 that the parties have agreed to a sixty (60) day continuance in the hearing of the Union's unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint against the County set for hearing before the PELRB on June 30, 1998 and given that the parties are expecting receipt of a fact finder's report which may resolve the terms for a successor collective bargaining agreement within that same sixty (60) day period, the Motion to Continue is GRANTED. Either party may request rescheduling of this case for a hearing during the period of this continuance. If there is no motion from either party to reopen these proceedings within the sixty (60) day continuance period, the ULP complaint shall be dismissed from the PELRB's docket of cases.
