STIPULATED ORDER

The parties, appearing before the undersigned hearing officer at the offices of the PELRB in Concord, New Hampshire on October 15, 1998, agreed and stipulated as follows:

1. The parties appeared before a PELRB hearing officer on October 15, 1998 in the matter of an unfair labor practice complaint filed August 6, 1998 and denominated Case No. M-0591:25. Respondent's answer was filed August 18, 1998.
2. The parties advised the hearing officer, in person and by pleadings, that the underlying subject matter of Case No. M-0591:25 is also the subject matter of the final step in the grievance process, i.e., final and binding arbitration under Article 10 of the CBA, in Case No. M-0591:20. The parties have agreed to the appointment James Litton to be the arbitrator in Case No, M-0591:20.
3. The parties agreed to proceed with the arbitration process in Case No. M-0591:20 and to hold the ULP

in Case No. M-0591:25 in abeyance the meantime. They further agreed that the arbitration proceedings shall be controlled by the Voluntary Labor Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association. The parties agree to notify PELRB upon receipt of Arbitration Litton's award in Case No. M-0591:20.

4. The processing of the ULP in Case No. M-0591:25 will be held in abeyance until thirty (30) days after the issuance of Arbitrator Litton's award in Case No. M-0591:20. If neither party requests further processing of Case No. M-0591:25 within the aforesaid thirty (30) day period, it shall thereafter be dismissed from the PELRB's docket of cases.

The foregoing stipulation of the parties is hereby adopted as the decision of the hearing officer.
