MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on December 10, 1998, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the Board's Motion for Rehearing filed on November 10, 1998 and the Association's objections thereto filed on November 23, 1998, as supplemented on November 24, 1998.
2. It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the Association on July 10, 1998 and the answer filed by the Board on July 23, 1998.
3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 1998-088) in this matter dated October 21, 1998, noting in particular and contrary to the assertions made in Items 1 and 6 of the Board's rehearing request that its decision did not contemplate or direct that the Board continue any wage payment practice which is in violation of federal and/or state laws and/or regulations. (See Decision No. 1998-088, page 5, para. 3.)

4. The PELRB's order to negotiate and to maintain the *status quo* in the meantime as directed in Decision No. 1998-088 is AFFIRMED, subject to the caveat, as explained in the decision itself, that this directive is not intended to cause violations of state or federal laws or regulations, and the Board's Motion for Rehearing is DENIED.
