ORDER TO CONTINUE

Whereas the Nashua Police Patrolman's Association filed unfair labor practice charges against the Nashua Police Department, City of Nashua on June 1, 1999 and the City answered those charges on June 16, 1999, said cause of action being identified as Case No. P-0749:9 and

Whereas the parties, both represented by counsel, filed the following joint stipulation with the PELRB on July 9, 1999, to wit:

The parties request that the hearing in the above-captioned matter be postponed on the docket of the PELRB until they shall each have reviewed and ratified, or rejected, the tentative collective bargaining agreement between them for the period of July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2002, inasmuch as joint ratification of that agreement will dispose of the pending unfair labor practice charges in Case No. P-0740:9. If the tentative agreement is not ratified by October 1, 1999, either of the parties may request that a hearing in this matter be scheduled on the PELRB's docket of cases. If neither party requests the scheduling of this matter for hearing on the PELRB's docket of cases before October 1, 1999, it shall thereafter be administratively dismissed by the PELRB.

It is ORDERED that this case stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until October 1, 1999, subject to further disposition in accordance with the parties' joint stipulation.
