MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on October 13, 1999, took the following actions:


- 1. It reviewed the Union's Motion for Rehearing filed on October 1, 1999 and the Town's objections thereto filed on October 8, 1999.
2. It examined the three underlying unfair practice complaints filed in case nos. M-0656:6, M-0656:7 and M-0656:8 filed on February 2, 1998, March 13, 1998 and February 5, 1999, respectively, and the

answers thereto as well as the two arbitration awards referred to therein, dated December 10, 1997 and January 6, 1999, respectively.

3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 1999-089) in these matters dated September 20, 1999, noting, in particular, that the parties had received the "benefit of their bargain" to arbitrate, both under the CBA and the subsequent stipulation of April 9, 1998 (Decision No. 1998-033).
4. It DENIED the Union's Motion for Rehearing.
