ORDER TO CONTINUE


Whereas the Londonderry School District filed unfair labor practice (ULP) charges against the Londonderry Education Association, NEA-New Hampshire on October 4, 1999 alleging a violation of RSA 273-A:5 II (d) and (f) for attempting to arbitrate a non-arbitrable subject, said Association having filed its answer to those charges on October 15, 1999; and

Whereas collateral proceedings in another forum, i.e., judicial proceedings, have been scheduled during the month of January, 2000, which may be dispositive of the pending ULP; and

Whereas the parties have agreed to set this matter forward on the Board's hearing schedule from December 16, 1999 to February, 2000, said action being in the interests of judicial economy,

IT IS ORDERED that this matter stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until February 15, 2000, with either or both parties being directed to give notice to the PELRB on or before that date if they seek further hearing in this matter or have otherwise resolved it.
