
MOTION FOR REHEARING

The Board, meeting at its office in Concord, New Hampshire, on September 14, 2000, took the following actions:

1. It reviewed the Motion for Rehearing filed by the District on August 18, 2000 and the Association's objections thereto filed on September 5, 2000.
2. It examined the unfair labor practice (ULP) complaint filed by the District on October 4, 1999, the Association's answer filed on October 15, 1999 and the parties' post-hearing briefs both filed on June 14, 2000.
3. It reviewed its decision (Decision No. 2000-046) dated July 19, 2000, noting that this decision was directed to the issue of access to the grievance and arbitration procedure under the contract and not to the merits of the case.
4. It DENIED the Motion for Rehearing.
