ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE

On October 12, 2001 both parties to this action communicated their mutual desire to the PELRB that the hearing scheduled for October 16, 2001 be continued. The stated basis for the continuance is that the parties have reached a tentative settlement that would be dispositive of all issues in this case. Both parties asked leave for time to allow submission of the tentative agreement to their respective ratifying bodies.

Therefore, this matter is hereby CONTINUED until Tuesday, November 27, 2001 in the event that the tentative agreement is not ratified by both parties. In the event that both parties ratify the tentative agreement, AFSCME, as the initial complainant, shall immediately submit a copy of the ratified agreement to the PELRB. Thereafter, the case shall be marked "Complaint withdrawn upon agreed stipulations" and all proceedings shall be terminated.
