ORDER

WHEREAS written notification dated October 14, 2003 has been received from the representative of the Complainant stating that the parties are in agreement that this matter should continue to be held in abeyance for the purpose of allowing the parties additional time to resolve their dispute as to the interpretation of the arbitrator's award and the merits of the instant complaint, it is hereby:

ORDERED that this matter shall stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until December 15, 2003. The parties shall notify the PELRB as soon as possible in the event that they are able to reach a formal settlement. If neither party shall have sought an additional hearing inclusive of a pre-hearing conference on or before December 15, 2003, this matter shall be dismissed without prejudice from the PELRB's docket. Otherwise, in the event that the parties are unable to settle the instant matter by said date, a pre-hearing/status conference will be scheduled forthwith.
