
INTERIM ORDER

The Board, after considering the utilization of arbitration in the above pending matter hereby issues the following interim order:

1. The parties are order to proceed to completion of the arbitration process unless resolution is otherwise achieved by settlement;
2. The instant matter shall be held in abeyance on the Board's docket pending the issuance of an arbitration award;
3. The Union's counsel or representative shall provide the Board with a status report on the arbitration proceedings every thirty (30) days and an immediate notice of the date of issuance of the arbitration award and;
4. Unless either party files a request for further proceedings within thirty (30) days of the issuance of said award, this matter shall be administratively dismissed.
5. Any applicable limitation on actions shall be tolled pending the completion of the arbitration process.
