
**ORDER ON MOTION TO STAY**

On July 21, 2009 the State filed a Motion to Stay these proceedings because the State has filed an appeal of PELRB Decisions 2009-103 and 2009-068 issued in cases P-0754-21 and 22, cases which the State asserts involve claims and issues similar to those raised in the above captioned matter. On July 22, 2009 the New Hampshire Troopers Association notified the PELRB that, without waiving any rights, it assents to the Motion to Stay. Accordingly, the Motion to Stay is granted. There shall be no further proceedings in this case until the pending Supreme Court appeal involving cases P-0754-21 and 22 is complete. Within thirty days of the completion of the pending Supreme Court proceedings either party may file a request for further proceedings in this matter, failing which the case shall be dismissed.
