

ORDER

Counsel for the parties participated in a conference call on January 15, 2010 concerning the pending hearing, the Town's motion to dismiss, and related matters. The present circumstances are that the Town's pending motion to dismiss was filed on January 13, 2010 and the adjudicatory hearing is scheduled for January 21, 2010. Prior filings and decisions reflect that the subject of the motion to dismiss was contemplated at the time of pre-hearing, and the parties agreed during the conference call that it should be considered at the outset of the January 21, 2010 proceedings. Accordingly, in accordance with Pub 203.04 (d), the Union shall file its objection to the motion to dismiss on or before 12:00 p.m. on January 20, 2010. The Union is also granted leave to submit a supplemental filing in support of its objection at the time of hearing on January 21, 2010, but the objection scheduled for January 20, 2010 should set forth sufficient detail as to the basis for the Union's objection.
