## CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and in accordance with RSA 273-A:8, 273-A:10, and Pub 301.01, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that SAU 38 EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, NEA-NH has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT:

Speech and Hearing Pathologist, School Psychologist, Occupational Therapist, Special Education Coordinator, Special Education Teacher, Human Resources Coordinator, Vocational Coordinator, Director of Technology, Speech and Language Assistant, Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant, Receptionist, Payroll Coordinator, Manager of Purchasing and Accounts Payable, Purchasing and Accounts Payable Assistant, Assistant to Director of Student Services, Student Services Assistant, and Administrative Assistant to Superintendent.

EXCLUDED: Superintendent of Schools, Assistant Superintendent for Hinsdale and Winchester, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, Administrative Assistant to the Assistant Superintendent for Hinsdale and Winchester, Financial Manager, Business Administrator, Assistant Business Administrator, Director of Human Resources, and Director of Student Services.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
