CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2011-100 granting the Association's petition for modification, the existing certification set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2003-011 is amended; and it is hereby certified that the AFSCME Local 2301/Seabrook Supervisory Employees Association is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT:

Assistant Recreation Dept. Director, Deputy Town Clerk, Lieutenant Detective, Water Department Superintendent, Operations Lieutenant, Recreation Director, Welfare Officer, Code Enforcement Officer, Deputy Fire Chief, Deputy Police Chief, Chief Operator-Wastewater Treatment Plant, Part-time Assistant Code Enforcement Officer, Finance Manager, Recreation Program Director, Animal Control Officer, Assessor, Water & Sewer Superintendent, Public Works Manager, Emergency Management Director, Assistant Code Enforcement Officer, Assistant Finance Manager, Computer Systems Administrator, and Water Department Chief Operator.

EXCLUDED: Mosquito Control Director, Civil Defense Director and Deputy Town Treasurer.

Further, it is ordered that the above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
