Background:


On March 29, 2011, the City filed an agreed upon modification petition to add the positions of Police Secretarial Supervisor and Assistant Fleet Maintenance Supervisor to the Nashua Police Department professional employees bargaining unit represented by the United Auto Workers Professional Employees of the Nashua Police Department, Local 2232 (UAW). The Assistant Fleet Maintenance Supervisor position is currently in a bargaining unit represented by the Teamsters Local 633. See PELRB Decision 2008-140. The City's petition to remove the Assistant Fleet Maintenance Supervisor position from that bargaining unit is currently pending. See *City of Nashua Board of Police Commissioners and Nashua Police Department Civilians, Teamsters Local 633*, PELRB Decision No. 2011-116.

DECISION

1. "Parties" means the UAW, the City, or their counsel/representative appearing in the case. The parties shall simultaneously copy each other electronically on all filings submitted in these proceedings.
2. Whether the requested modification is appropriate depends in part on the disposition of contested proceedings in the pending case of *City of Nashua Board of Police Commissioners and Nashua Police Department Civilians, Teamsters Local 633*, Case No. G-0168-1. Accordingly, this petition shall be held in abeyance pending the completion of proceedings in the case of *City of Nashua Board of Police Commissioners and Nashua Police Department Civilians, Teamsters Local 633*, Case No. G-0168-1.
