ORDER


On April 6, 2011 the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to resolve a question of representation of certain Hooksett Police Department employees. The subject bargaining unit contains the following positions: regular full time Patrol Officers, Detective, and Dispatcher. See PELRB Decision No. 2001-007M. The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (April 26, 2011).

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on April 8, 2011 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than April 25, 2011. No objections, exceptions or petitions to intervene have been filed.

Accordingly, the NEPBA's request for a secret ballot election to resolve the question of representation is granted. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled in accordance with Pub 303.02.
