ORDER

The City filed an agreed upon modification petition to add the positions of Police Secretarial Supervisor and Assistant Fleet Maintenance Supervisor to the Nashua Police Department professional employees bargaining unit represented by the United Auto Workers Professional Employees of the Nashua Police Department, Local 2232 (UAW). Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than April 14, 2011 but none have been filed. Accordingly, the City's petition is granted. An amended certification shall issue forthwith.
