Order

On October 17, 2011 the SEA/SEIU Local 1984 filed an election petition seeking certification of a bargaining unit comprised of certain adjunct faculty employed by Plymouth State University. The University objected to the composition of the proposed bargaining unit and an adjudicatory hearing was scheduled for November 17, 2011. Prior to hearing the parties reached agreement that the appropriate composition of the proposed bargaining unit is as follows:

All undergraduate adjunct faculty who are employed by Plymouth State University and who have taught at least five semesters in the last five years or who have currently begun their fifth semester of teaching and have taught four semesters in the past five years.


Exclusions: All full time employees; all research faculty; all graduate assistants; all student teaching supervisors; all performance studies instructors; all other supervisors, managers and confidential employees.

Based upon the foregoing the parties have agreed upon an appropriate bargaining unit in accordance with RSA 273-A:8 and Pub 302 and the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election

to determine the exclusive representative, if any, of the bargaining unit. An order of election shall issue and a pre-election conference scheduled forthwith.
