Order

On January 20, 2012 the Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire filed a petition for certification seeking to represent a bargaining unit consisting of certain employees of the Rockingham County Sheriff's Department. The petition was supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (January 27, 2012). On March 13, 2012 the parties informed the PELRB that they reached an agreement on the unit composition and on March 22, 2012 the parties filed a stipulation reflecting that they agree on the following composition of the proposed bargaining unit:

Sergeant, Dispatch Supervisor, Network Administrator, Chief
Electronics/Communications Technician.

Excluded: High Sheriff, Major, Captain, Lieutenant.


Based on the foregoing, the undersigned finds that the parties have agreed upon an appropriate bargaining unit in accordance with RSA 273-A:8 and Pub 302.

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on January 20, 2012 and duly posted by the employer, petitions to intervene were due no later than February 6, 2012. No petitions to

intervene have been filed. Accordingly, an Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled pursuant to Pub 303.02.
