**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE**


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A), and a secret ballot election having been conducted in accordance with RSA 273-A:10 as reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2012-143, it is hereby certified that the National Correctional Employees Union, Inc. has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

**UNIT:** Shift Supervisor, Corrections Officer, Medical Services Coordinator, Corrections Nurse, Secretary, Maintenance Engineer, Maintenance Worker II, and Training Officer.

**EXCLUDED:** Administrator, Director of Operations, Director of Safety and Security, Director of Inmate Work Program, Director of Rehabilitation, and Administrative Secretary.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
