
On January 23, 2013 the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to resolve a question of representation of an existing bargaining unit. The subject bargaining unit, currently represented by the AFSCME Council 93, contains the following positions within the Town of Pelham Police Department: All Patrolmen, Sergeants, full time and part time Clerk/Dispatchers, and Animal Control Officers. See PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. A-0465 (February 18, 1992). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (February 4, 2013).

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on January 24, 2013 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than February 8, 2013. No objections, exceptions, or petitions to intervene have been filed.

Accordingly, the NEPBA's request for a secret ballot election to resolve the question of representation is granted. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled in accordance with Pub 303.02.
