A representation election will be conducted under RSA 273-A:10 for:

Unit: All Patrolmen, *Sergeants*, full time and part time Clerk/Dispatchers, and Animal Control Officers.

Notice to Public Employer:

Pursuant to Pub 303.01 (b), the public employer shall immediately forward to the board, and to the parties who shall appear on the ballot, a complete list of the names and home addresses of the employees in the bargaining unit agreed to by the parties or previously determined by the board to be eligible for membership as a result of a unit determination hearing. The public employer shall update this voting list by delivering to each party receiving a copy of the original list the name, classification and home address of any person newly eligible for inclusion in the bargaining unit up to the end of the eligibility period agreed to by the parties or, failing agreement, determined by the board at the pre-election conference.
