Order

On June 26, 2013, the New England Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (NEPBA) filed a challenge petition for certification in above captioned case requesting a secret ballot election to resolve a question of representation of the Town of Windham Police Department bargaining unit currently represented by the AFSCME Council 93, Local 3657. See PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. A-0531 (December 17, 1986).<sup>1</sup> The petition is supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards. See PELRB Report re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (July 8, 2013).

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on June 27, 2013 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than July 11, 2013. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed. Accordingly, this case shall proceed to a secret ballot election to resolve a question of representation of the following bargaining unit.

UNIT: Patrolmen, Dispatchers, Sergeants, and Corporals employed by the Town of Windham Police Department.


EXCLUDED: Chief of Police and Captains.
