
On August 19, 2013 the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a Petition for Certification seeking to represent the following proposed bargaining unit:

**Unit:** Sergeants, Network Administrator, Dispatch Supervisors, and Chief Electronics/Communications Technician of the Rockingham County Sheriff's Department.

**Exclusions:** Sheriff, Major, Captain, Lieutenant, Deputy, Reserve Deputy, and Dispatcher.

The County agrees with the proposed unit composition. The petition was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the September 19, 2013 Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. Pursuant to the PELRB Notice of Filing, issued on August 19, 2013 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than September 3, 2013. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed. Per RSA 273-A and N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 300 the petition is granted and the proposed bargaining unit is approved. An Order for Election shall issue.
