Order

On September 16, 2014 the New England Police Benevolent Association, Inc. filed a petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Grafton County Department of Corrections. The petition for certification was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the September 24, 2014 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. No objections, exceptions or petitions to intervene have been filed.

On October 8, 2014 the parties participated in a telephonic conference concerning the composition of the proposed bargaining unit, scheduled by the PELRB. Based on the parties' representations at the conference, the parties agree to the following composition of the bargaining unit:

Unit: Full Time Corrections Officers and Part Time Corrections Officers.

Excluded: Superintendent, Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant, Corporal, and all other Grafton County employees.

The bargaining unit proposed by the parties is approved. The PELRB will conduct a

secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. New England Police Benevolent Association, Inc. and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled pursuant to Pub 303.02.
