Order

On May 5, 2015, the AFSCME Local 2301/Seabrook Supervisory Employee Association filed an agreed upon petition for modification pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 302.05 seeking to add the position of Chief Procurement Officer to the description of the existing bargaining unit. See PELRB Decision No. 2013-266 (December 23, 2013). Pursuant to the PELRB Notice of Filing, issued on May 5, 2015, exceptions, objections, and petitions to intervene were due no later than May 20, 2015. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case. The petition for modification is hereby granted. Accordingly, a modification order shall issue forthwith.
