Order

On December 18, 2015, the Town filed an assented to motion to continue the December 22, 2015 hearing because the parties have agreed to proceed to arbitration on any and all issues related to the implementation of the arbitration decision and award.¹ The parties also request that the above-captioned matter remain on the PELRB docket during the pendency of the arbitration proceedings. The assented to motion to continue is granted and the December 22, 2015 hearing is cancelled. The parties shall file the arbitration schedule with the PELRB as soon as it is established. The parties shall also file a report with the PELRB about the status of the arbitration proceeding on or before April 1, 2016, at which time the PELRB will issue a further order as appropriate and necessary.
