#### **Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit**

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2016-184 granting the City's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2004-140 (September 20, 2004), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the AFSCME Local 1580, Concord City Employees for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:
