Order

On August 10, 2016, the National Correctional Employees Union (Union) filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Grafton County, Department of Corrections (County). The petition for certification was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the August 15, 2016 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

On August 24, 2016, the parties filed an agreement on the composition of the proposed bargaining unit. The parties agree to the following proposed unit composition.

Unit: Full Time Corrections Officers.


Excluded: Corrections Corporals, Corrections Sergeants, Corrections Lieutenants, Corrections Captains, and all other employees of Grafton County.

The proposed bargaining unit is approved. The PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved

unit, if any. "National Correctional Employees Union" and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Pub 303.02.
