Order

On August 10, 2016, the National Correctional Employees Union (Union) filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Sullivan County Department of Corrections (County). The petition for certification was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the August 15, 2016 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. The County objected to the petition and a hearing on objection was scheduled for September 29, 2016.

On September 20, 2016, the parties filed a Stipulation as to the Composition of the Bargaining Unit. Based upon the Stipulation, the parties agree to the following proposed unit composition.

Unit: All full time Corrections Officers employed by the Sullivan County Department of Corrections.

Excluded: Corporals, Sergeants, and all other employees of Sullivan County.

The bargaining unit proposed by the parties is approved. Accordingly, the adjudicatory hearing scheduled for September 29, 2016 is cancelled. The PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. "National Correctional Employees Union" and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Pub 303.02.
