Order

On October 5, 2016, the National Correctional Employees Union (NCEU) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit comprised of certain employees of the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections (County) currently represented by the Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire (Teamsters). See PELRB Decision No. 2007-111 (July 31, 2007). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report Re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (October 18, 2016).

The subject bargaining unit contains the following Hillsborough County Department of Corrections positions:

Unit:

Lieutenants, Corrections Training Assistant, Maintenance Supervisor, Work Release Supervisor, Education Director, Records Supervisor, E.I.P. Supervisor, Classification/Corrections Officer, Project Supervisor, Housekeeping Assistant, Correctional Officer II (Sgts.), Food Service Supervisor, Housekeeping Supervisor, Account Clerks II, Nurse II, Cook II, Maintenance II, Secretary II, Teacher, and Mental Health Clinician.

See PELRB Decision No. 2007-111. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have

been filed in this case.

The NCEU's request for a secret ballot election to resolve the question of representation

is granted. The PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to

determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit, if any. "Teamsters Local

633 of New Hampshire", "National Correctional Employees Union", and "No Representative"

will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election

conference shall be conducted in accordance with Pub 303.02.
