Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2016-288 granting the Association's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2013-205 (October 15, 2013), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the New England Police Benevolent Association for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

Unit:

Sergeants, Network Administrator, Communications Shift Supervisors,

and Chief Engineer.

Excluded:

Sheriff, Major, Captain, Lieutenant, Deputies, Reserve Deputies, and

Dispatchers.

The Rockingham County Sheriff's Office shall negotiate with the New England Police Benevolent Association as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the New England Police Benevolent Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
