**Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate**

Pursuant to PELRB Decision No. 2017-011 (January 19, 2017), the Laconia Patrolman Association is now affiliated with the New England Police Benevolent Association. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, the Laconia Patrolman Association, affiliated with New England Police Benevolent Association, is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances:

**Unit:** All Patrol Officers and Detectives.

**Excluded:** Chief of Police, Captains, Lieutenants, Detective Sergeants, Detective Corporals, Sergeants, and all other employees of the Laconia Police Department.

The City of Laconia Police Department is ordered to recognize the affiliation and negotiate collectively with the Laconia Patrolman Association, affiliated with New England Police Benevolent Association, on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the Laconia Patrolman Association, affiliated with New England Police Benevolent Association, to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
