Order

Mr. Fournier filed this case on July 24, 2017 and he generally complains about union voting procedures relating to a collective bargaining agreement ratification vote held at the end of June, 2017. As relief, he requests a "[r]evote on the union with the possibility of decertification." As reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2017-144 (August 15, 2017), employees in the bargaining unit filed a decertification petition on June 28, 2017 which, after hearing, resulted in an order approving the request for a representation election. At election, a majority of the eligible employees who voted chose no representative, which resulted in a decertification order. See PELRB Decision No. 2017-185 (October 18, 2017). On November 21, 2017 Mr. Fournier notified the PELRB that this case can be closed. Accordingly, the pending pre-hearing conference and hearing are both cancelled. Case dismissed.
