Order for Election

The Public Employee Labor Relations Board will conduct a representation election under RSA 273-A:10 for the following Merrimack County Sheriff's Office bargaining unit:

Unit: Corporal, Deputy (full time), Deputy (part time), Dispatcher, Investigator, and Clerical/Support Staff.

Excluded: Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant, Dispatch Supervisor, Administrative Assistant, and On Call/Per Diem Deputies.

Parties and choices appearing on ballot:

- Teamsters Local 633
- New England Police Benevolent Association
- No Representative

Notice to Public Employer:

Pursuant to Pub 303.01 (b), the public employer shall immediately forward to the board and to the parties who shall appear on the ballot, a complete list of the names and home addresses of the employees in the bargaining unit. The public employer shall update this voting list by delivering to each party receiving a copy of the original list the name, classification, and home address of any person newly eligible for inclusion in the bargaining unit up to the end of the eligibility period as determined at the pre-election conference.
