<u>Conway School District v. AFSCME Council 93, Local 859, AFL-CIO</u>, Decision No. 2007-003 (Case No. A-0453-10).

District claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by improperly requesting arbitration over non-payment of performance based wage increases during status quo period while contract did not include evergreen clause. PELRB held that dispute was not arbitrable and that contractual performance based wage increases were not enforceable during status quo period.
