<u>Hillsboro-Deering Support Staff, AFT-NH, Local 6219, AFL-CIO v. Hillsboro-Deering School District</u>, Decision No. 2007-091 (Case No. E-0031-1).

Union claimed that district committed unfair labor practice by attempting to harass and intimidate union president in retaliation for her actions on behalf of union during contract negotiations. PELRB dismissed complaint finding that union failed to demonstrate that any of district's actions were in retaliation for union activity.
