

Professional Employees of the Nashua Police Department, Clerical, Technical, and Professional Units, UAW, Local 2232 v. City of Nashua, Nashua Boards of Public Works, Fire Commissioners and Police Commissioners, Decision No. 2007-102 (Case Nos. P-0774-1, G-0044-1, G-0043-1).

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by failing to approve three times contractual cost items contained in proposed bargaining agreement. PELRB dismissed complaint because union failed to file it within six month statutory limit after town's initial rejection of contract terms and because town's decision was within rights granted to legislative body in RSA 273-A:3, II (c). PELRB ordered parties to return to bargaining table.
