

Portsmouth NH Police Patrolmen's Union, NEPBA Local 11 v. Portsmouth Police Commission, Decision No. 2007-140 (Case No: P-0709-28).

Union claimed that commission committed unfair labor practice by ordering police officers to remove union pins from their uniforms. PELRB issued order prohibiting commission from directing officers to remove union insignia from their uniforms finding that public employees had a right to wear union insignia under RSA 273-A.
