<u>Concord Police Supervisors Association v. City of Concord</u>, Decision No. 2007-150 (Case No. P-0792)

PELRB granted union's petition to certify bargaining unit comprised of positions of lieutenants and sergeants over city's objections. PELRB found that all proposed positions shared community of interest and that city's evidence was insufficient to show that supervision exercised by lieutenants in relationship to sergeants rose to level constituting significant exercise of discretions.
