NEPBA Local 255/NH Supervisory Corrections Officers, IUPA, AFL-CIO and State of New Hampshire, Department of Corrections & NEPBA Local 250/New Hampshire Corrections Officers Unit, IUPA, AFL-CIO and State of New Hampshire, Department of Corrections, Decision No. 2007-153 (Case No. S-0438-1 and Case No. S-0437-1).

NEPBA filed petitions for modification and certification. Incumbent representative filed exceptions and motions to dismiss opposing NEPBA's request that employees be provided with opportunity to vote to choose representative and claiming that NEPBA's petition was untimely and required 30% showing of interest. PELRB granted union's petitions to certify and modify bargaining units and ordered matter to proceed to elections finding that petitions were timely and 30% requirement was satisfied.
