<u>State Employees' Association of NH, Inc., SEIU, Local 1984 and Town of Meredith</u> Decision No. 2009-098 (Case No. G-0066-1).

<u>Background:</u> The union filed a written majority authorization petition seeking to be certified as an exclusive representative of a bargaining unit comprised of certain positions within the Town of Meredith Public Works and Water and Sewer Departments. The town filed exceptions claiming that the proposed bargaining unit is improper because it lacks community of interest and because the Public Works Assistant Director position, included in the proposed unit, is a supervisory position.

<u>Decision:</u> The PELRB granted the petition finding that there is sufficient community of interest between the employees of the Water and Sewer Departments and employees of the Public Works Department. The PELRB excluded the position of the Public Works Assistant Director from the unit finding that the position is supervisory.
