

Program Title: Foster Care/Adoption Services

- Short Description: Temporary FMAP increase of 6.2 percentage effective 10/1/2008 through 12/31/2010
- FMAP increased above 56.2% based on increases in unemployment rates
- By September 30, 2011, states must report on how these funds were expended
States must pay claims timely to remain eligible for increased FMAP
