

New Hampshire Implementation -American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Program Title: Homeless Prevention (Emergency Shelter)

Short Description: Funds to be used for eligible homeless prevention/intervention activities.

ARRA Appropriation nationwide: \$1,500,000,000

Estimated New Hampshire Funds: \$4,612,322

Granting Agency: U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development

Managing Agency: Department of Health & Human Services

Status: Information received from on HUD on 3/19/09

Award Criteria: Funds to be used for provision of short or medium term rental assistance, housing relocation, and stabilization services including housing search, mediation or outreach to property owners, credit repair, security or utility deposits, utility payments, rental assistance, moving cost assistance, case management or activities related to rapid re-housing of homeless persons

Time Line: . 60% of funds must be expended within 2 years of date funds become available, 100% must be expended within 3 years of that date. Un-expended funds at the 2 year date (60%) will be subject to the “recapture” and reallocation.
