

New Hampshire Implementation -American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Program Title: Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants for 10 Largest Cities and Counties

Short Description: Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants to be provided directly to the State's largest ten cities and counties.

ARRA Appropriation nationwide: \$1,904,000,000

Estimated New Hampshire Funds: \$2,929,400

Granting Agency: U.S. Department of Energy

Managing Agency: Cities and Counties receiving funds.

Status: Funding announced on 3/26/09.

Award Criteria: The percentage allocated varies with the size of the cities and counties that qualify for an allocation.

Time Line for use: Preference to activities that can be started and completed expeditiously, including a goal of using at least 50 percent of the funds for activities that can be initiated not later than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this Act. Recipients shall also use grant funds in a manner that maximizes job creation and economic benefit. ARRA, Sec. 1602.
